## Yoncalla Pond Litter Control Project

**Objective:** To keep the 80 acre pond area as litter-free as possible.

**Litter Control Plan:** Use volunteers to do a litter sweep around the main pond on a weekly basis. Individual responsibility would be once per month (typically on Thursday). Note: a loop sweep can be accomplished within an hour.

Volunteers would be assigned a specific day for each month (example, 1<sup>st</sup> Thursday, 2<sup>nd</sup> Thursday, etc.)

**Recommended Equipment / supplies:**

- Gloves
- Appropriate footwear
- Trousers / slacks and long sleeved shirt
- Hand pruner to trim blackberry cane as needed.
- Large garbage bag
- A pole or stake with a nail through the end to snag litter

Notify NDB in the event there are exceptional litter accumulations / problems and we will deal with them.

Work safely. Be aware that there may be poison oak in the vicinity.

After completing the task, notify NDB so we know that it was completed for that week.
